Short project description	In our project, we seek for various organisations with experience and knowledge on economical and juridical education for social entrepreneurship in Baltic Sea Region. This kind of experience would serve as the basis of our major expertise/research on youth social entrepreneurship around BSR – does such entrepreneurship exist? If yes, then to what extent? How does it work? Research carried out in this project would also answer the following questions: what is the current institutional potential to support youth social entrepreneurship? What are the best institutions to support this issue? What are the best practices available to share around the Baltic Sea Region? The project outcome would be the starting point for creating the platform of cooperation on behalf of youth social entrepreneurship in the Baltic Sea Region (especially the South Baltic). The project is directed to the young people, who are particularly threatened by the exclusion in the labour market.
