GDAŃSK SAFE CITY

Dear Visitor,

Welcome to the city of Gdańsk. Before you begin exploration of the city, please open the flyer and read the information. You can also use the map.

We want you to feel safe. In any case of threat please call 112 or 986 (Municipal Guard Operation Centre).



Smoking in public places is prohibited

You can smoke only in designated areas. Smoking at bus stops, beaches, bars and restaurants, health centers and any other public places is prohibited, unless there is designated area.

Alcohol consumption only in designated public places

Alcohol consumption can take place only in designated places such as bars, pubs, restaurants etc. Drinking on the beach, in parks, in the means of public transportation, bus stops etc. is prohibited.

CCTV

For your safety, downtown and other crowded places of the city are covered by video surveillance.







Limited traffic area

Please notice that the historical part of the Old Town is a limited traffic area (see a map). The zone is signed by B-1 road sign /No vehicles/ with exceptions. The zone can be entered only by vehicles which have a permit. If you need to drive into the area, please purchase the appropriate validation from Municipal Guard patrol or at Municipal Guard Headquarters. Elblajaka 54/60 street.
