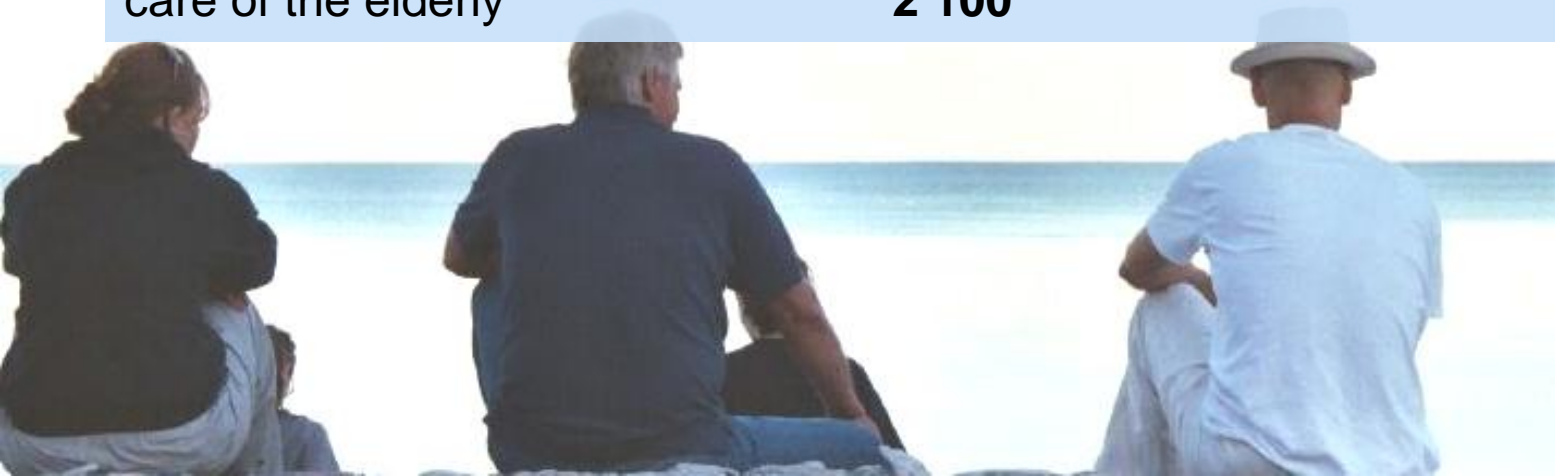
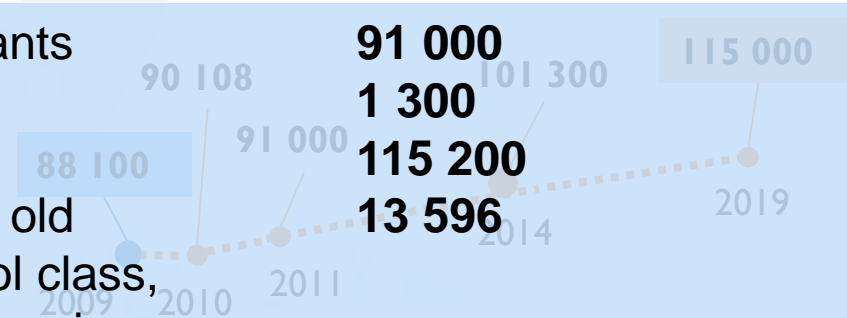

# Intensive Home Construction

A total of **36 500** households.  
In 2010, 250 new homes were built  
including 180 detached/semi-detached/  
terraced houses.

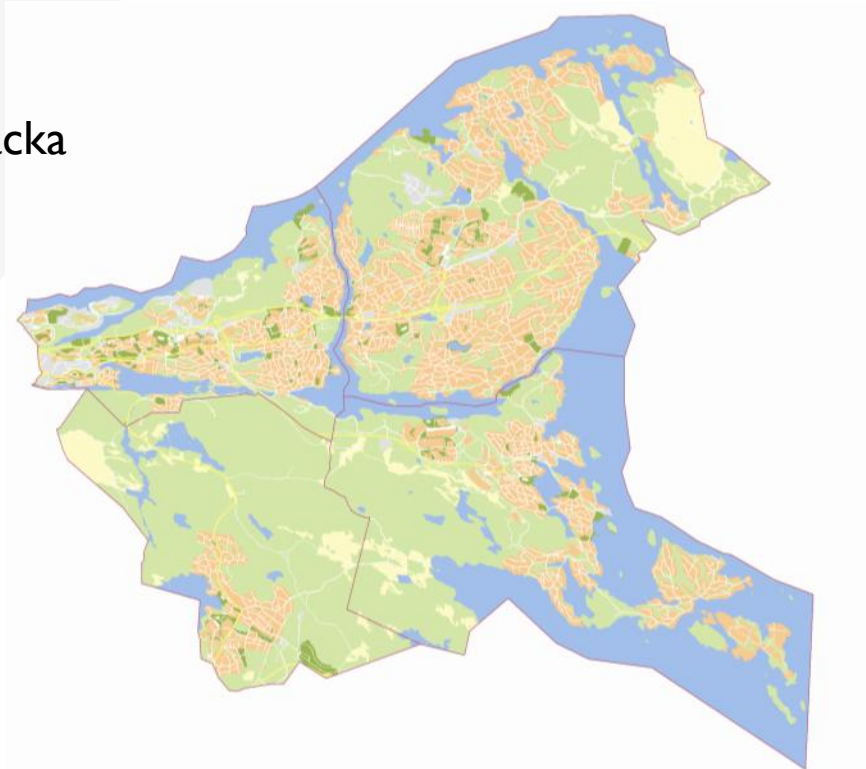

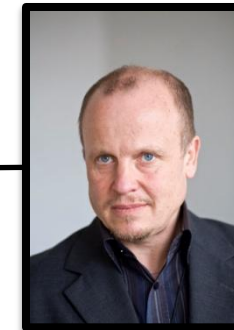

# Security and Safety versus(?)

## Feeling of safety

*Are we striving for a secure or a safe community?*

**Security** and Safety can have its focus on “hard” areas:

- Locks
- Alarms
- Guards
- Police
- Fire brigade

**Safety or Feeling of Safety** touches the “soft” areas – social sustainability

- Children and adolescents
- Elderly people
- Disabled people
- Individuals and groups being left outside
- People with a low standard of education
