Network of Science Parks

This will become increasingly important as the "low knowledge jobs" within the UBC region will continue to be exported to countries like India and China. The fruitful cooperation with Europe's largest and oldest Science Park Sophia Antipolis (France) should be further developed.

Place Marketing

Global competition for export markets, capital and business locations make targeted profiling and national and international positioning of individual business locations within the UBC an absolute necessity. This is true particularly given the increasing mobility of workers and businesses, the increasing internationalization of the economy, and the increasing rapidity of structural change towards knowledge economies. The objective is to inform about effective and proven strategies for international place marketing.

- Continuation of activities in connection with the BaltMet Promo project.

Cooperation and Partnership

Collaboration, networking and mutual understanding is crucial for success. With this initiative the Business Commission wishes to promote systematic contact to the relevant economic associations within the Baltic Sea Region and in Europe. The responsible business development agencies of the UBC member cities shell be linked together and get informed about chosen economic regions. A business delegation trip should be organized in 2013.
