What can we do to ensure, that young people gain proper education and training, find work opportunities and become integral members of our societies?

The Confederation strives for a society founded on solidarity. The DGB offers future-oriented concepts for a social market economy which is tailored to the changed social conditions of today. Mr Polkaehn is a SPD member with the rich experience in local policy.

The youth representatives, as well as the cities, will both prepare their plan of action to combat youth unemployment and marginalization.
