Słupsk Poviat

- Total area: 2304 sq. Km
- Unemploment rate: 21 %*



Who we are?



- Pomeranian Regional Development Agency Joint Stock Company was set up in 1994
- Main stakeholders: Marshal Office of Pomerania Region (53%), City of Slupsk (24%), National Treasury (14%), City of Koszalin (5%), Commune of Slupsk (2%), others private ones (2%).

3 main fields of activity:

- administration of Słupsk Special Economic Zone
- administration of Słupsk Technology Incubator
- Regional development, including EU projects

Regional development



- Implementation and running EU projects for regional development
 24 projects of amount over 20 mln EUR
- Supporting entrepreneurship and labor market
 250 SME's created, 3000 people joined in trainings
- Strengthening the social economy sector 11 social cooperatives
- Strenghtening the vocational education
- Promotion of investment attractiveness, cluster initiatives
- Economic missions for entrepreneurs

Slupsk Special Economic Zone



- The richest offer of investment lands for industrial and service activities in the Middle Pomerania! 900 ha.
- Large, compact investment areas, near the main communication routes
- 17 locations in the Regions of Pomerania and West Pomerania (member of Invest in Pomerania Initiative)
- Favourable tax exemptions (income tax exemptions up to 55% of eligible investment costs)
- Support in the development of cooperative relations
- Friendly investment climate

What is special economic zone for?



- speeding up development of the Polish regions,
- developing and utilizing new technical and technological solutions in the national economy,
- increasing the competitiveness of goods and services,
- developing the potential of industry and the infrastructure,
- creating new work places.

Incetives



Companies active within the SSEZ can take advantage of public assistance in the form of **income tax exemption (up to 55%)** allowed for new investment or new employment (public aid can be utilized by 31st December 2026).

There are also other forms of public aid:

- Real estate tax exemptions
 (the level depends on each municipality's regulation)
- EU Grants
- Government Grants

Each of the aid is subjected to be sum up together.

The national level: amount for Poland is **EUR 82,5 billion** incuding Inteligent Development Programme – **EUR 8,6 billion**

The regional level:

amount for Pomerania Region is **EUR 1,86 billion**

Slupsk Special Economic Zone



- Total area: 900 ha
- Number of subzones: 17
- Permits: 125
- Employment: 4000 people
- Investment expenditures:

PLN 1,3 billion (approx. EURO 315 mln):

PLN 560 mln (EUR 135 mln) – foreign investments, from which PLN 60 mln (EUR 14,6 mln) Scandinavian investments.
