The city networks and the institutional-transnational networks are one of the most remarkable challenges and opportunities of the next European future

In fact, as described by many studies and in particular by the so-called Barca Report for the redefinition of the post 2014 Community cohesion polices, only the effectiveness of processes of cohesion and resource exploitation that go beyond the administrative and national borders can allow Europe and to its national and regional components, to play a remarkable role in the future global competitions.

To face these challenges the Maritime OP has developed a priority axis which favours the sharing of the relevant resources belonging to the different networks of the area in order to increase the competitiveness of the cross border zone.
