tools to make people better at generating new ideas and working with them. They also focus on the group dynamics behind a creative environment.

In the lecture/workshop Idea Factory, we will dismiss the "artist myth" - that creativity is a gift of the chosen few, like a divine inspiration. On the contrary, all psychological research points to the fact that creativity is something that everyone possesses, and that it is a skill that can be practiced.
