Building the Inclusive City

City Planning seminar with Focus on Gender Equality and Children's Perspective



ABOUT THE SEMINAR- Background and theme

Background

Umeå is one of the fastest and most steady growing municipalities in Sweden and the biggest city in northern Sweden. The city has about 120 000 inhabitants and has experienced strong expansion since the 1950's when the university was founded. In 2008 the municipality decided on a new target for population growth aiming at 200 000 citizens by 2050. Umeå is working ambitiously with several masterplans for different areas to plan for the expansion. Because of the steady growth, 67% of the inhabitans today are "immigrants" not born in the city. That's one reason why Umeå today is described as a very tolerant and inclusive city.

Theme and focus of the seminar

Umeå has a long tradition of involving gender issues in the physical and social planning and the university of Umeå has a Center for gender studies which is appointed as one of three "Centers of Gender Excellence" in Sweden. At this seminar we integrate a gender equality perspective and also include a focus on children's perspective. One challange that Umeå has, probably shared by all cities that are trying to densify the city centers, are how to plan for good environments for children to grow up in.

The first part of the seminar will involve academic inputs and presentations illustrating good examples and methods to work with social sustainability in urban planning. We will also participate in a guided bus tour and visit-Umeå with a focus on gender equality and a child's perspective. The second part involves discussions and practical group work that will give input to the urban planning of Umeå as an inklusive city.

Site 1. Umeå city center

The heart of Umeå. The typical urban block structure contains a mixture of dwellings, businesses and shops. The city center also contains important public functions, transportation and social meeting places.

In Umeå as in many parts of the world there is a trend that more children grow up in central densely populated areas. How can we make the city center to a place for children?


Site 2. Former freight yard and military stables

This area contains two different parts. One part is the former military stables that today is mostly used for storage and parking. The other is an area along one of the main roads in the city and the railway through town. Changes in both the road- and railway structure will make this an interesting area of transformation.

Group work using the Social Impact Analysis-method (SIA)

The aim of the groupwork is to come up with fresh ideas and development proposals for the sites that also includes the social dimensions making Umeå an inclusive and attractive city to live in.

The groups will get to test and use elements from the SIA-method within the framework of the matrix showed belove. Social characters concerning age and gender will be divided within each group before inventorying the workshop sights. The purpose is to add social perspectives and important findings in this matter into the group discussions and solutions.




