Mountain Suur Munamägi (318 m), which is located in the middle part of Haanja uplands (Võru county), is the highest point in Estonia and other two Baltic countries.

On the top of the Suur Munamägi there is an observation tower – the view from 346.7 meters is 50 km in radius.

The pedestrian path, that takes you to the tower, is located in Haanja village. If you are coming from Võru - the observation tower of Suur Munamägi is on your left. The beginning of the pedestrian path is marked with signs and guidelines.
