

Trelleborg has two special landmarks. One is the palm trees growing everywhere in the city and community during the summer time. The roads are lined with the palm trees, there are palms in the roundabouts, on squares, in the harbours.

The palm trees have been a dear symbol of the southernmost city in Sweden the last thirty years. The first 25 palm trees were brought from Alicante in Spain in 1984 and today the city has about 200 palm trees. They were brought here to mark that here in Trelleborg starts Continental Europe.
