



The Viking fortress Trelleborgen was originally build in 980 by the Danish king Harald Blåtand, Harald Blue tooth, and was the first one to be found in Scania in 1980's. In Denmark there are four of these fortresses, but the one in Trelleborg is the biggest and the only one that is partly rebuilt. It's located in the heart of the city center and it's open to the public year round – there is a museum and in summertime daily excursions and lot of events.
