

The tower of Aalborg



Enjoy beautiful views of Aalborg - Take the elevator 55 feet up and enjoy the stunning views of the city and Vendsyssel. The tower is the city's landmarks, although the tower was meant as a temporary mono meant. The tower is built in 1933 in North Jutland. Situated on Skovbakken is the platform 105 meters above sea level. Up here you have the opportunity to enjoy food and drink from the bistro.

Utzon Center



Utzon Center in Aalborg is an experimental cultural center where architecture, design, art and communication form a synthesis. The center was designed by renowned architect Jørn Utzon.

Utzon Center was opened in May 2008 and is the first in a series of cultural activities along the waterfront in Aalborg.

In addition to changing exhibitions, the house contains also the beautiful Spidsgatterbåd, designed by Jørn Utzon's father, Aage Utzon.



Aalborg Zoo welcomes you to a visit with some of the world's great species. You can visit the polar bears in their new and renovated polar bear facility or come face to face with a Sumatran tiger clean.
