JURMALA

Jurmala is the city by the Gulf of Riga stretching along 33 km of coastline with modern relaxation and resort facilities. It has become the largest resort area in the Baltics. It is very convenient to reach, as the resort city is located only 25 km from the capital of Latvia – Riga and 15 km from international airport "Riga". New and renovated hotels offer modern tourism facilities for every visitor. City's largest draw is white sand beach stretching along 26 km. Jurmala characterized by its 19th century wooden architecture with woodcut accents, cottage-style buildings and resort centers. Jurmala as a resort is known for more than 150 years and is famous for its healthy climate, medical mud and mineral waters, which are used for healing purposes.
