

How to get?

From Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport to Gdynia: the nearest airport is Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport (http://www.airport.gdansk.pl/). The easiest way to get to Gdynia is by taxi. Bus line 4A shuttles to Gdynia almost every two hours (http://www2.zkmgdynia.pl/index_rozklady.php?linia=4A). 4A stops near conference venue – at bus stops: Redłowo SKM - Park Technologiczny or Centrum Nauki Experyment

The main railway station in Gdynia is Gdynia Glówna. National and international railway connections: http://beta.rozklad-pkp.pl/en.

Public transport: buses, trolleybuses, Rapid Urban Railway - SKM

Trolleybuses and regular buses (ZKM) are the most popular means of transport in Gdynia. Tickets can be purchased at newsagents as well as from the driver in each bus and trolleybus. Ticket prices and timetables can be found here http://www.zkmgdynia.pl/?lang=uk). The bus stops closest to conference venue are Redłowo SKM - Park Technologiczny and Centrum Nauki Experyment (bus/trolleybus lines: G, R, S, Z, 4A, 4T, 21, 23, 24, 26, 27, 29, 321,326)

SKM trains run more or less every 10-15 minutes between 5 am and 7 pm through the Tri-City (Gdynia, Sopot and Gdańsk) and less frequently outside these hours (http://www.skm.pkp.pl/en/). The closes SKM station is **Gdynia Redłowo**.



How to get? – travelling by public transport in Gdynia

Hotel Kuracyjny -→ Conference venue

Go to bus stop Orłowo SKM and use trolleybus line 21, 26 or bus line S. Stop at bus stop Centrum Nauki Experyment

Hotel Kuracyjny → Dinner place "Coco"

Go to bus stop **Orlowo SKM** and use trolleybus line 21. Stop at bus stop Skwer Kościuszki - Infobox and walk through the Skwer Kościuszki street to Gdynia Waterfront building (old Centrum Gemini)


Hotel Orbis Gdynia **→** Conference venue

Go to bus stop Skwer Kościuszki - Infobox or Wybickiego at Świętojańska street and use Trolleybus line 21, 23 or 24. Stop at bus stop Centrum Nauki Experyment

Hotel Orbis Gdynia → Dinner place "Coco"

The restaurant is located at Skwer Kościuszki in Gdynia Waterfront building (old Centrum Gemini), 5 min by foot from the hotel
