

## **Bright Education for All!**

The Bright Education for All Congress: activating and practical methods throughout the learning path will be taking place in Tampere, Finland from April 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

The congress will provide a forum for introducing various learner-centered, workbased and activating methods for promoting learning and preventing exclusion.

The 2016 congress in Tampere will showcase the entire activating learning path to both national and international participants. The objective is to give an overall picture of how learner-centric and activating pedagogy is achieved in practice at different levels of the learning path. Attention is also given to the multifaceted learning environment and the development future know-how today.

The programme consists of parallel sessions of expert presentations and workshops as well as visits to Finnish learning institutions. There is evening programming for participants, as well.

In addition, both international and Finnish participants will present their own emerging. The purpose of the congress is to create a participatory and interactive cross-pollinating experience where every participant can inspire and be inspired.
